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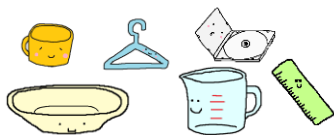

Recyclable Waste

Plastic Products (Made Entirely of Plastic)



- ☑ Only plastic household items in the following categories:
(Kitchenware, Sanitary Products, Stationery Items, and Storage Containers)

- ✗ Items marked with the Japanese Plastic Packaging Symbol
⇒ **Burnable Waste**



PET Bottles



Before Disposal

- ☑ Remove the cap and label. The ring may remain attached.
- ☑ Caps and dirty items that cannot be cleaned ⇒ **Burnable Waste**



Empty cans



How to Dispose

- ☑ Use up all contents and release any remaining gas before disposal.

Glass bottles



Ineligible Items

- ✗ Return reusable sake bottles (1.8 L) and beer bottles to the retailer.
- ✗ Broken bottles:
- ✗ Non-food and Non-beverage bottles: ⇒ **Non-burnable waste**
- ✗ Bottles with non-removable caps: ⇒ **Non-burnable waste**

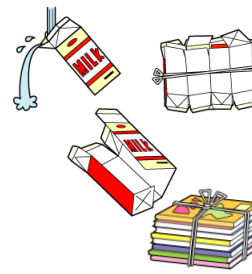


Mixed Paper



Before Disposal

- ☑ Put items out on the designated collection day.
- ☑ Corrugated cardboard: Cardboard with a visible wavy layer in the cross-section.
- ☑ Milk and Beverage Cartons: Rinse, open, and dry.
(Silver-lined cartons ⇒ **Burnable Waste**)
- ☑ Small paper items: Put in a paper bag or envelope and bundle with magazines.



Before Disposal

- ☑ Clean off any dirt.
Rinse and dry.
- ✗ Items that cannot be cleaned by rinsing (e.g., oily items) should be disposed of as **Burnable** or **Non-Burnable** waste.
- ☑ Use a semi-transparent bag and tie it tightly.
- ☑ Remove all parts made of different materials.
- ✗ If not removable, dispose of as **Non-Burnable** waste.
- ☑ Remove all stickers.
- ✗ If not removable, dispose of as **Non-Burnable** waste.



How to Bundle

- ☑ Tie securely with strong string. (Plastic string is acceptable.)
- ☑ Heavily soiled items should be disposed of as **Burnable Waste**.

Burnable Waste (Combustible Waste)



Food Waste

Drain food waste thoroughly before disposal.



Non-recyclable paper waste (e.g., paper cups)

Seal postcards, soiled paper, and receipts are also burnable waste.



Branches and Wood waste

Up to 40cm long and 8cm in diameter.



Diapers

Remove solid waste before disposal.

Styrofoam

Break large items into smaller pieces and place them in the designated bag.



Clothing and shoes

Remove metal parts whenever possible. Small metal parts may be left attached.

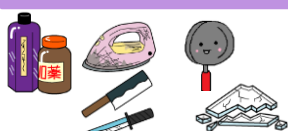


Rubber items such as garden hoses

Cut long items into lengths of 1m or less

Non-Burnable Waste

Non-Burnable Waste (Glass, Ceramics, Metal Items, and Other Non-Burnable Materials)



- ☑ Cut off the cords.
- ☑ Place tapes in a separate bag.
- ☑ Remove batteries before disposal.
- ☑ Take items with non-removable batteries to an authorized recycler.
- ✗ Rechargeable batteries must be taken directly to a designated collection facility.



Hazardous Waste

(e.g., Fluorescent Lamps, Batteries)

- ✗ Do not dispose of rechargeable batteries here.



Metal Items (Separate Collection)

(e.g., Golf Clubs, Chains, Metal Tools)



- ☑ Place in a separate bag from non-burnable waste.

Disposal Rules

- ☑ Use an Ono City designated garbage bag and tie it securely closed.
- ☑ Limit the contents of each bag to about 10kg.
- ☑ Place glass, wire, blades, and similar items in a sturdy bag and label it (e.g., "Glass").

How to Dispose

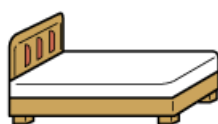
- ☑ Take directly to View Clean Okuetsu Recycling and Disposal Center (size restrictions apply).
- ☑ If you cannot transport it yourself, contact an authorized waste contractor.



Important Information

- ☑ Illegal dumping is prohibited.

Bulky Waste



Drop-Off Size Limits

Rod-shaped items: up to 2.0m long and 10cm in diameter.



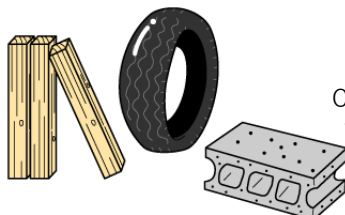
Box-shaped items : up to 1.1m × 1.1m × 2.0m



Fabric rolls such as bed sheets : up to 2.0m × 2.0m



Items Not Accepted By the City



Items larger than bulky waste, or items that cannot be disposed of at View Clean Okuetsu Recycling and Disposal Center.

Contact a licensed industrial waste disposal contractor.

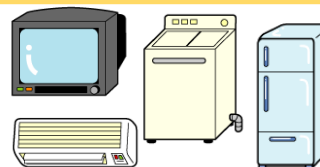
Industrial Waste

Contact the retailer.

Home Appliance Recycling Items

Air conditioners, TVs, Refrigerators, Washing Machines
Contact the retailer or an authorized waste contractor.
Or take the item directly to a designated collection site.
